

Legendary American Hall of Fame skier Dan Egan launches 2021 UK Tour

Dan Egan, the legendary extreme skier who is featured in 12 Warren Miller ski movies, has announced a short tour visiting three English cities following his 2021 book launch, *Thirty Years in a White Haze*.

The tour will see Egan visit London, Manchester and Birmingham during October, where he'll be talking to audiences about some of the incredible experiences he's had all over the world and the writing of his new book.

Starting at The National Snow Show at the NEC Birmingham, the tour will also visit Ellis Brigham stores in Manchester and London.

There's also an exclusive talk for Ski Club of Great Britain members at the White Haus, Farringdon.

Dan Egan said: "I always look forward to visiting the UK and have spent many years at the ski shows in London. Now travel has opened up again, it felt like a great opportunity to come and share my stories with British skiers who are so passionate about the sport. This winter I'm planning to be back in Europe, running ski clinics in France (Val d'Isère) and Switzerland (Zermatt, Engelberg), so hopefully some of the people that come and see the talk will feel inspired to join me".

Featured in 12 Warren Miller Entertainment ski films, on the Discovery Channel, ESPN, Good Morning America, in Powder Magazine, and other media outlets, Dan Egan is an award-winning broadcaster and film producer, and a ski legend who continues to teach and share his love of the sport around the globe. Dan and his brother John Egan, as the Egan Brothers, travelled to some of the world's most remote regions following the geopolitical events of the 1980s and 1990s. They made first descents on the Berlin Wall, skied beside the Persian Gulf War, and organized the 1993 Middle East Peace Ski in Lebanon; the brothers were willing to ski wherever the world would watch and listen.

What a great book. Wish I'd written it! I also wish I could claim to have skied many extreme descents in Dan Egan's wake but it will never happen now! I even struggled skiing massive moguls with him in Smugglers' Notch, Vermont. He was very patient, but I just couldn't keep up! (To be fair, moguls are not my forte, particularly huge icy ones!) Apart from joining him skiing (gingerly) down the occasional couloir, the most enjoyable skiing I ever had with Dan was with my wife Vivianne on one of his couples clinics in Okemo, designed to stop the stronger skier in any couple dominating the day's skiing and scaring his or her weaker partner with too many challenges. My wife and I had a ball – literally – even dancing down the slopes arm-in-arm together in one of Dan's exercises. Dan has always been a kind and modest guy – both as a skier and a person - maybe partly as a result of a particularly frightening adventure on Mount Elbrus, when he was buried perilously in the snow. Luckily I wasn't with him!
